differently to create a relationship with Amber?

**8.** Do you think Linda changed or evolved through the challenges she faced with the new women in her family?s life?

**9.** Do you think Linda honored Theresa?s memory by the way she behaved?

10. If you could insert yourself as a character in the book, what role would you like to play?

11. After reading the book, do you have a more tolerant view of the choices people make?
