

This tantalizing tale should engage youthful readers and provoke discussion among those of high-school age and older. Caulfield, move over, there is much more to tell!

Discussion Guide

- 7. Discuss how life experiences in the past can cloud the reality of the present?

8. How does Gunner influence Q?s life? Do you believe this is possible?

9. How do you believe LaMar will handle his new reality?

10. What do you believe is Ma Lu?s mission in Washington DC? What secret has she been hiding?

11. What insights have you gained by reading The Whitest Wall? Has it changed your life or perception in any way?

12. The Whitest Wall contains parallel characters, who are they and how are they similar? Different?

13. What are the metaphors the author uses in The Whitest Wall?

14. Gunner left Q with unanswered riddles? Did he figure them all out?

15. What is the symbolism of the cover?

16. What is the definition of Bootleg?
