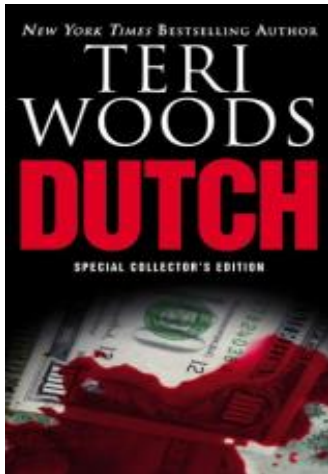


Dutch

7. Do you think Nina genuinely loved Dutch or loved his money and power?
8. Do you think Roberto knew who Dutch would become? That said, do you think people realize how much they

influence the youth around them?

9. Why do you think the people of New Jersey went crazy when Dutch was arrested? Shouldn't the neighborhood want someone like Dutch off the streets?

10. Do you agree with Roc's decision to leave the game? Why or why not?

11. Did you find yourself rooting for Dutch in the end? If so, why?

12. Were you happy with the ending? Why or why not?
