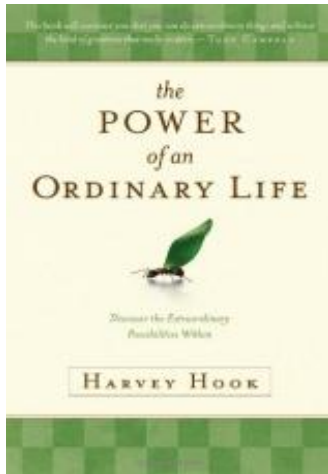


Power of an Ordinary Life
