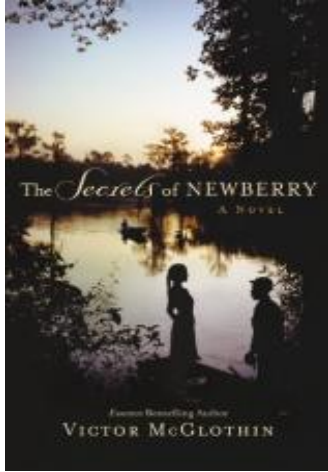


The Secrets of Newberry

10. What did you think of Bones's plan to murder several men, implicate Hampton, then get Detective Mouton to help carry it out?
11. Why do you think Odessa, Janeen, and Joyce all kept quiet about the priest?
12. Should Hampton have taken Magnolia away from the plantation after his release from prison?
13. Do you believe that Bones had to die in order for Hampton's family to survive?
14. What was behind Detective Cunningham's decision to let Hampton go?
15. Is protecting some secrets worth dying for? Are any worth killing to keep?
16. If you were filming this movie, who would you cast as Hampton, Magnolia, Bones, Pearl Lee, Toussaint, Detective Mouton, and Trotter?
